The CIEL Spring Symposium provides students from colleges in the consortium with an opportunity to share their scholarship in formal and informal settings and to meet students from across the country who have interests in similar questions. Students from all disciplines and areas are invited to participate. Presentations may address any aspect of social and environmental justice, as well as future global applications.

In addition to the methods and findings of the research, presentations should include discussion of implications and open questions related to the project that invite audience engagement and dialogue. Presenters should be prepared to invite and manage substantive conversation about their research. Time for each presentation and discussion will be about 15 minutes.

A proposal should be submitted in the form of a one-page abstract, due by February 15, 2007, to the CIEL campus coordinator on your campus.



Abstracts should include the following:

Title of Presentation

The discipline or subject area(s) to which it relates

Objectives of the presentation

Method and format (panel presentation, poster(s))

Three to five sentence summary of the content

Needed audio-visual equipment

Name of the presenter, institutional affiliation, mailing and e-mail addresses
